## 100 Healing Scriptures (King James Version)

1. **Jeremiah 30:17** – "For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the Lord; because they called thee an Outcast, saying, This is Zion, whom no man seeketh after."

“ God is a restorer who sees you even when others consider you an outcast; His healing reaches the wounds no one else sees.

2. **Jeremiah 33:6** – "Behold, I will bring it health and cure, and I will cure them, and will reveal unto them the abundance of peace and truth."

“ Divine healing is often accompanied by a revelation of God's deep peace and the truth of His character.

3. **3 John 1:2** – "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth."

“ God desires wholeness for you in every area—physically, materially, and spiritually.

4. **Ephesians 6:13** – "Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand."

“ Spiritual strength and the "armour of God" provide the resilience needed to remain steadfast during times of infirmity or trial.

5. **1 Peter 2:24** – "Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were

healed."

“ Your healing was paid for at the cross; it is a finished work of redemption provided by Jesus' sacrifice.

6. **James 5:14** – "Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:"

“ God provides a community and specific instructions for healing, emphasizing the power of corporate prayer and anointing.

7. **James 5:15** – "And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him."

“ The "prayer of faith" is a powerful tool that connects us to God's raising power and His total forgiveness.

8. **Hebrews 11:6** – "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him."

“ Approaching God for healing requires the foundational belief that He is good and rewards those who seek Him.

9. **Hebrews 13:8** – "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever."

“ Because Jesus never changes, the same healing power He demonstrated in the Gospels is available to you right now.

10. **Psalms 103:1** – "Bless the Lord, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name."

“ Worshiping God with your whole being shifts your focus from the illness to the One who is Holy.

11. **Psalms 103:2** – "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:"

“ Remembering God's past faithfulness and "benefits" builds your expectation for current miracles.

12. **Psalms 103:3** – "Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;"

“ God's power is comprehensive; there is no sin He won't forgive and no disease He cannot heal.

13. **Psalms 103:4** – "Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies;"

“ God rescues us from the "destruction" of sickness and covers us with His compassionate love.

14. **Psalms 103:5** – "Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's."

“ Divine healing brings a renewal of strength and vitality, allowing you to soar again.

15. **Matthew 8:16** – "When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick:"

“ Jesus' Word alone carries the authority to drive out darkness and cure every sickness.

16. **Matthew 8:17** – "That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses."

“ Jesus took your physical burdens upon Himself so that you don't have to carry them alone.

17. **Exodus 15:26** – "And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the Lord thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the Lord that healeth thee."

“ This verse introduces God's name, **\*\*Jehovah-Rapha\*\***, revealing His fundamental nature as your Healer.

18. **2 Chronicles 7:14** – "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."

“ Humility and seeking God's face lead to a broad healing that touches not just the individual but the entire "land".

19. **Acts 10:38** – "How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him."

“ Jesus' ministry was defined by "doing good" and actively destroying the oppression of sickness.

20. **Mark 16:18** – "They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover."

“ God uses human hands as conduits for His healing virtue; recovery is a promised sign for believers.

21. **Acts 28:8** – "And it came to pass, that the father of Publius lay sick of a fever and of a bloody flux: to whom Paul entered in, and prayed, and laid his hands on him, and healed him."

“ No specific ailment, like a fever or infection, is too small or too great for God to heal through prayer.

22. **Romans 10:17** – "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."

“ Reading these scriptures strengthens your faith, which is the "spark" for experiencing healing.

23. **Matthew 12:15** – "But when Jesus knew it, he withdrew himself from thence: and great multitudes followed him, and he healed them all;"

“ Jesus is not overwhelmed by the "multitudes"; He has enough power to heal every person who follows Him.

24. **Matthew 4:23** – "And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people."

“ Healing is an integral part of the "Gospel of the kingdom"—it is good news in action.

25. **Isaiah 53:5** – "But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed."

“ This verse connects spiritual peace with physical healing; both are results of Jesus' suffering for us.

26. **Luke 10:9** – "And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you."

“ When healing happens, it is a sign that God's kingdom and His presence are "nigh" (near) to you.

27. **Mark 11:24** – "Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them."

“ Faith involves "believing you receive" before the physical manifestation is seen.

28. **Titus 3:5** – "Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;"

“ Healing and salvation are gifts of God's "mercy," not something we must earn through our own perfection.

29. **1 Corinthians 10:13** – "There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it."

“ God is faithful to provide the strength to endure and the "way to escape" during physical trials.

30. **Jeremiah 17:14** – "Heal me, O Lord, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise."

“ This is a bold prayer of absolute trust: if God does the healing, it is permanent and sure.

31. **2 Peter 3:9** – "The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance."

“ God is patient and his desire is for your total well-being—He does not delight in suffering.

32. **John 10:10** – "The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly."

“ Sickness is a thief, but Jesus came to give you "abundant life" in every part of your being.

33. **Proverbs 4:20** – "My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings."

“ Giving God's Word your full "attention" is the first step toward finding His life and health.

34. **Proverbs 4:21** – "Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart."

“ Healing happens when we keep God's promises at the center of our thoughts and affections.

35. **Proverbs 4:22** – "For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh."

“ God's words are like a "medicine" that brings health to your physical "flesh".

36. **Deuteronomy 7:15** – "And the Lord will take away from thee all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon thee; but will lay them upon all them that hate thee."

“ God is a protector who actively removes sickness from His people.

37. **Matthew 7:21** – "Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven."

“ Knowing God intimately is about more than words; it is about aligning our lives with His will, where healing flows.

38. **Romans 8:28** – "And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose."

“ Even in the midst of illness, God is working behind the scenes to bring about a good purpose for your life.

39. **1 Corinthians 14:33** – "For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints."

“ Sickness often brings confusion, but God is the author of "peace," which is essential for restoration.

40. **Matthew 28:20** – "Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen."

“ You are never alone in your struggle; the Great Physician is with you "always".

41. **Isaiah 53:4** – "Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted."

“ Jesus carried your "griefs" and "sorrows" (which include physical and mental pains) so you can be free.

42. **Psalms 118:17** – "I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord."

“ This is a confession of life and a commitment to use your healed life to give God glory.

43. **Luke 10:19** – "Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means

hurt you."

“ Believers are given authority over the "power of the enemy," which includes the attack of infirmity.

44. **Mark 9:23** – "Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth."

“ Faith removes the word "impossible" from your vocabulary regarding healing.

45. **Deuteronomy 3:22** – "Ye shall not fear them: for the Lord your God he shall fight for you."

“ You don't have to fight for your health alone; the Lord Himself fights on your behalf.

46. **Revelation 21:4** – "And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away."

“ God's ultimate plan is a state of perfect health where "pain" and "tears" no longer exist.

47. **Mark 16:17** – "And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;"

“ Miracles and "signs" are natural outworkings of a life lived in faith.

48. **Mark 5:34** – "And he said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague."

“ Faith has the power to make you "whole," which means complete restoration beyond just the symptoms.

49. **Exodus 23:25** – "And ye shall serve the Lord your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee."

“ Serving God brings a blessing on your daily provisions and a promise of health.

50. **Jude 1:3** – "Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints."

“ We must "contend" or stand firm for our faith in God's healing power.

51. **James 5:16** – "Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much."

“ Honest relationship and "fervent prayer" are keys that unlock healing power.

52. **Proverbs 17:22** – "A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones."

“ Joy is not just an emotion; it is "medicine" for your physical body.

53. **2 Corinthians 12:7** – "And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure."

“ Even in times of persistent struggle, God’s purpose is to keep us close to Him and humble.

54. **2 Corinthians 12:8** – "For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me."

“ It is right to persist in asking the Lord for relief and healing.

55. **2 Corinthians 12:9** – "And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me."

“ When you are weak, you have access to the "perfect strength" of God's grace.

56. **Acts 19:11** – "And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul:"

“ God is a God of "special miracles"—He can do the unusual and the extraordinary.

57. **Acts 19:12** – "So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them."

“ God’s healing power is so tangible it can even be transmitted through simple objects.

58. **Acts 14:8** – "And there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked:"

“ God can heal conditions that have existed "from birth"—nothing is too long-standing for Him.

59. **Acts 14:9** – "The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed,"

“ Faith is often "perceived" by others; it is a visible trust in God's ability.

60. **Acts 14:10** – "Said with a loud voice, Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked."

“ Healing often requires an act of obedience—rising up to do what you previously could not.

61. **Luke 13:13** – "And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God."

“ Jesus’ touch brings immediate restoration and leads us to glorify God.

62. **Luke 6:19** – "And the whole multitude sought to touch him: for there went virtue out of him, and healed them all."

“ There is a "virtue" or power that flows from Jesus that is sufficient for "all".

63. **Luke 4:18** – "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,"

“ Jesus' mission includes healing for the "brokenhearted" and "bruised," not just physical eyes or limbs.

64. **Matthew 9:35** – "And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people."

“ Jesus was proactive in His healing ministry, reaching people where they were.

65. **Psalms 147:3** – "He healeth the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds."

“ God is a gentle physician who "binds up" the emotional wounds of the heart.

66. **Psalms 30:2** – "O Lord my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me."

“ Healing often starts with a simple "cry" for help to the Lord.

67. **1 Corinthians 12:7** – "But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal."

“ Spiritual gifts, including healing, are intended for the "profit" and benefit of the whole body of Christ.

68. **1 Corinthians 12:8** – "For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;"

“ Wisdom and knowledge from the Spirit are often the first steps in understanding how to pray for healing.

69. **1 Corinthians 12:9** – "To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;"

“ "Gifts of healing" are specifically provided by the Holy Spirit to bring about restoration.

70. **1 Corinthians 12:10** – "To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:"

“ Miracles are a broader category of God’s power that supersedes natural laws to bring wholeness.

71. **1 Corinthians 12:11** – "But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will."

“ All healing comes from the same "selfsame Spirit"—God is the source.

72. **Luke 18:43** – "And immediately he received his sight, and followed him, glorifying God: and all the people, when they saw it, gave praise unto God."

“ Your healing will be a testimony that causes others to "give praise unto God".

73. **Luke 5:17** – "And it came to pass on a certain day, as he was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power of the Lord was present to heal them."

“ The "power of the Lord" is a tangible presence that can be felt and experienced for healing.

74. **Mark 6:5** – "And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them."

“ Even in atmospheres of doubt, Jesus still finds ways to reach and heal individuals.

75. **Mark 6:6** – "And he marvelled because of their unbelief. And he went round about the villages, teaching."

“ Unbelief may "marvel" the Lord, but He continues to teach the truth that leads to faith.

76. **Mark 1:41** – "And Jesus, moved with compassion, put forth his hand, and touched him, and saith unto him, I will; be thou clean."

“ Jesus is "moved with compassion"—He \*wants\* you to be healed.

77. **Matthew 10:8** – "Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give."

“ God's power is given "freely"—you don't have to pay for it or earn it.

78. **Psalm 41:3** – "The Lord will strengthen him upon the bed of languishing: thou wilt make all his bed in his sickness."

“ God is your "Good Shepherd" who cares for you even while you are restricted to a sickbed.

79. **Deuteronomy 32:39** – "See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither is there any that can deliver out of my hand."

“ God is sovereign; His hand is the ultimate authority over life and healing.

80. **James 1:6** – "But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed."

“ Asking with a firm, "non-wavering" faith provides a stable foundation for receiving from God.

81. **James 1:7** – "For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord."

“ This verse reminds us that double-mindedness can hinder the flow of God's blessings.

82. **1 Timothy 5:23** – "Drink no longer water, but use a little wine for thy stomach's sake and thine often infirmities."

“ God can use natural means and practical advice for our health and "often infirmities".

83. **Acts 20:9** – "And there sat in a window a certain young man named Eutychus, being fallen into a deep sleep: and as Paul was long preaching, he sunk down with sleep, and fell down from the third loft, and was taken up dead."

“ This record shows that God's power is superior even to accidental death.

84. **Acts 20:10** – "And Paul went down, and fell on him, and embracing him said, Trouble not yourselves; for his life is in him."

“ "Life is in him"—God can restore life and breath where it seems to have vanished.

85. **Acts 20:11** – "When he therefore was come up again, and had broken bread, and eaten, and talked a long while, even till break of day, so he departed."

“ Restoration allows us to return to the simple joys of fellowship and service.

86. **Acts 20:12** – "And they brought the young man alive, and were not a little comforted."

“ Seeing God's power at work brings great "comfort" to our souls and our families.

87. **Acts 17:10** – "And the brethren immediately sent away Paul and Silas by night unto Berea: who coming thither went into the synagogue of the Jews."

“ Seeking God often requires moving forward in faith, even in the middle of a "night" season.

88. **Acts 17:11** – "These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so."

“ Being "noble" means searching these healing scriptures daily to build a rock-solid faith.

89. **Acts 9:33** – "And there he found a certain man named Aeneas, which had kept his bed eight years, and was sick of the palsy."

“ Palsy or long-term paralysis is not beyond the reach of the Great Physician.

90. **Acts 9:34** – "And Peter said unto him, Aeneas, Jesus Christ maketh thee whole: arise, and make thy bed. And he arose immediately."

“ It is "Jesus Christ" who makes you whole; we simply receive and act on His command.

91. **John 20:30** – "And many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book:"

“ God's healing works are so numerous they couldn't even be fully recorded—He is still doing "unwritten" signs today.

92. **John 9:6** – "When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay,"

“ God can use unconventional methods to bring about your miracle.

93. **John 9:7** – "And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing."

“ Obedience ("go, wash") is often the final step before the "seeing" or manifest healing.

94. **John 9:1** – "And as Jesus passed by, he saw a man which was blind from his birth."

“ Jesus "sees" you in your condition; you are never invisible to His mercy.

95. **John 9:2** – "And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind?"

“ We must move past blaming ourselves or others and look to God’s power.

96. **John 9:3** – "Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him."

“ Your situation is an opportunity for the "works of God" to be made manifest to the world.

97. **John 5:14** – "Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee."

“ Spiritual health and righteous living help preserve the physical wholeness God gives.

98. **Luke 8:50** – "But when Jesus heard it, he answered him, saying, Fear not: believe only, and she shall be made whole."

“ "Fear not" is the antidote to the anxiety that often accompanies sickness.

99. **Luke 4:39** – "And he stood over her, and rebuked the fever; and it left her: and immediately she arose and ministered unto them."

“ Jesus has authority to "rebuke" the symptoms of disease, bringing immediate relief.

100. **Psalms 146:8** – "The Lord openeth the eyes of the blind: the Lord raiseth them that are bowed down: the Lord loveth the righteous."

“ God "loves" you and His specific joy is to lift up those who are "bowed down" by illness.

May these words dwell in you richly and produce the fruit of health and peace. Remember that your body is the "temple of the Holy Ghost," and God is glorified when you live in His strength. As you close this guide, may the "peace of God, which transcends all understanding," guard your heart and mind in Christ Jesus.

Go forth in the confidence that "by his stripes ye are healed".
